WHEN YOU RETURN.



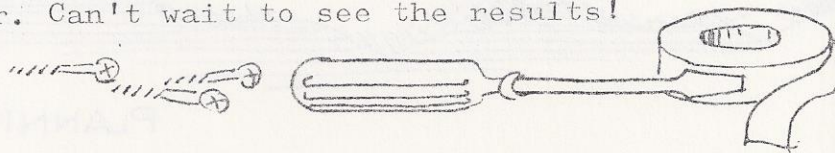

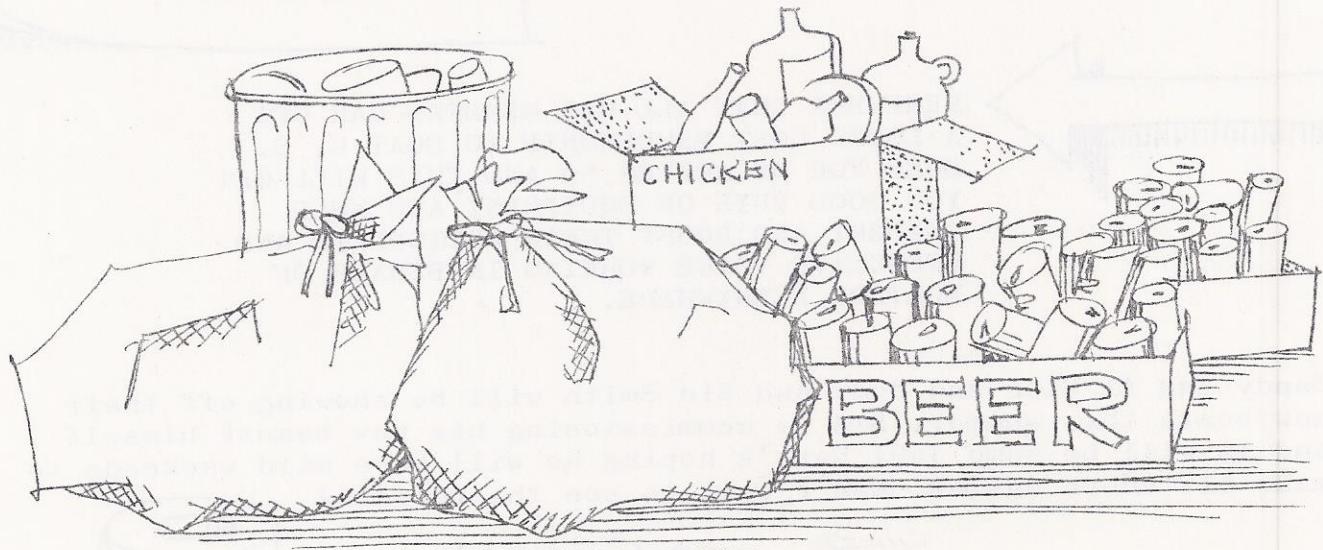
