

HOW TO GET TO THE DOWNS COMMUNITY CLUBHOUSE

From the BALTIMORE beltway go south on Rt #3. Take Rt #178 East (Generals Highway to Crownsville and Annapolis). About \(\frac{1}{4} \) mile past Eisenhower Golf Course turn left onto Old Rt #178. Go \(\frac{1}{4} \) mile and turn left onto Sherwood Forest Road \(\frac{1}{4} \) Go \(2/10 \) mile and turn right onto Coach Way (there is a "Downs" sign on the corner) and go \(1\frac{1}{2} \) miles. Turn left onto St. Edmonds Place, make a quick right onto Brookside Common and turn right into the parking lot.

From the WASHINGTON beltway go east on Rt #50 about 18 miles to the first Annapolis exit (Rt #450/178). Bear right off exit toward Crownsville. Go $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles on 178 to "Rudy's Tavern" on the left and a Sherwood Forest sign on the right. Turn right on Sherwood Forest Road.* (follow Baltimore directions from here on).


