how to get to the downs community clubhouse
From the BALTIMORE beltway go south on Rt \#3. Take Rt \#178 East (Generals Highway to Crownsville and Annapolis). About $\frac{1}{4}$ mile past Eisenhower Golf Course turn left onto Old Rt \#178. Go $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and turn left onto Sherwood Forest Road* Go $2 / 10$ mile and turn right onto Coach Way (there is a "Downs" sign on the corner) and go $1 \frac{1}{2}$ miles. Turn left onto St. Edmonds Place, make a quick right onto Brookside Common and turn right into the parking lot.

From the WASHINGTON beltway go east on Rt \#50 about 18 miles to the first Annapolis exit (Rt \#450/178) . Bear right off exit toward Crownsville. Go $2 \frac{1}{2}$ miles on 178 to "Rudy's Tavern" on the left and a Sherwood Forest sign on the right. Turn right on Sherwood Forest Road. * (follow Baltimore directions from here on).
