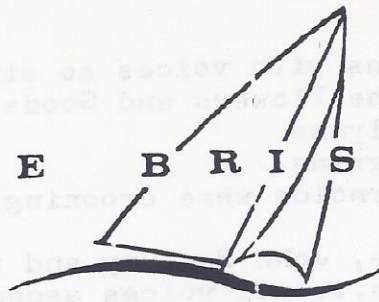




CHESAPEAKE BRISTOL CLUB

PROVIDE FRIED CHICKEN, BEER, WINE & SOFT DRINKS.

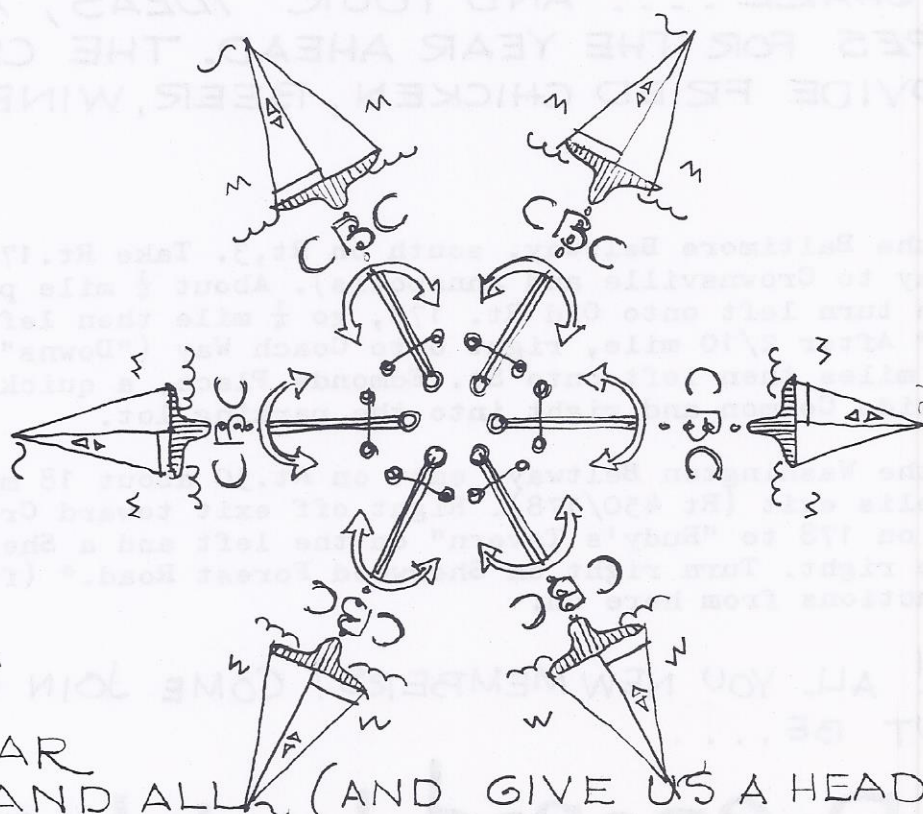

About $\frac{1}{4}$ mile past Eisenhower Golf Course turn left onto Old Rt. 178, go $\frac{1}{4}$ mile then left on Sherwood Forest Road.* After $2\frac{1}{10}$ mile, right onto Coach Way ("Downs" sign on the corner) Go $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles then left onto St. Edmonds Place, a quick right onto Brookside Common and right into the parking lot.

From the Washington Beltway, east on Rt. 50 about 18 miles to the first Annapolis exit (Rt 450/178). Right off exit toward Crownsville. Go $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles on 178 to "Rudy's Tavern" on the left and a Sherwood Forest sign on the right. Turn right on Sherwood Forest Road.* (follow Baltimore instructions from here on.
