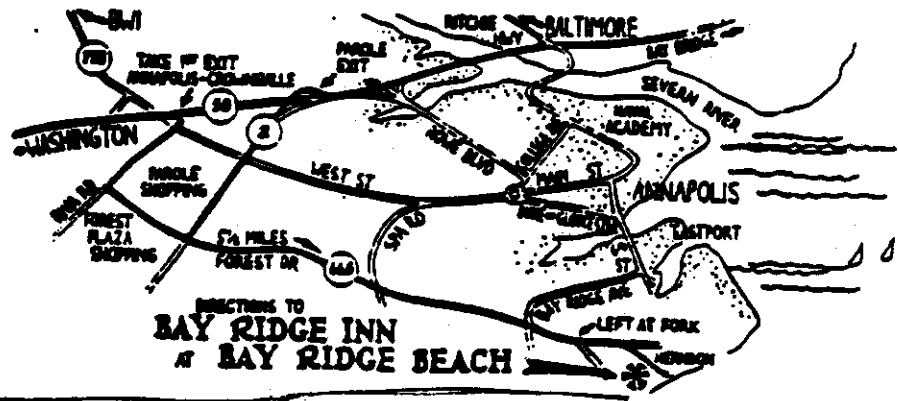

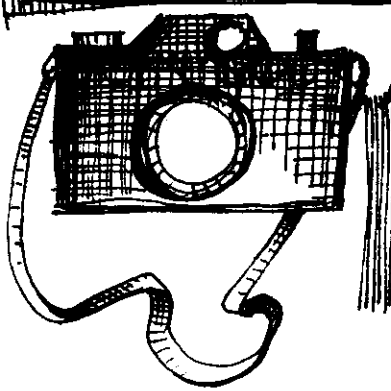

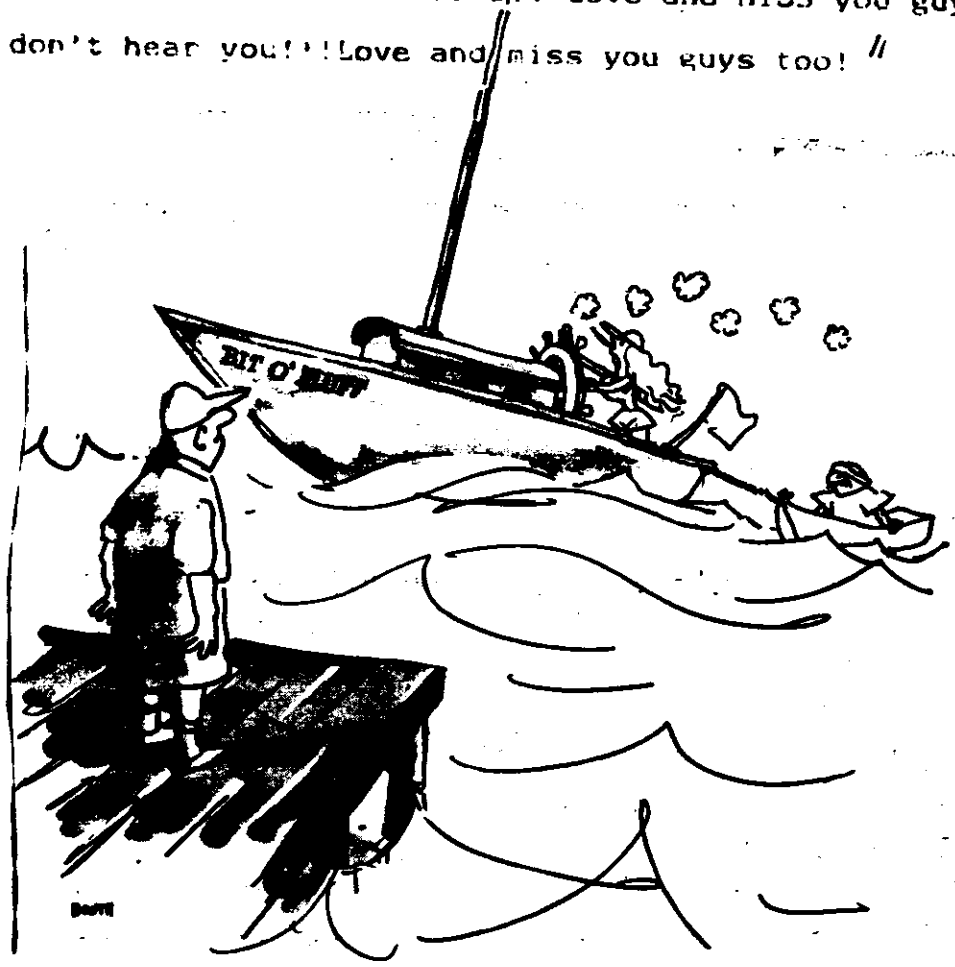
As you can tell...we sure are having a GREAT TIME!!! But we want you all to know we miss you all too and only wish you could be sharing these fun experiences with us.

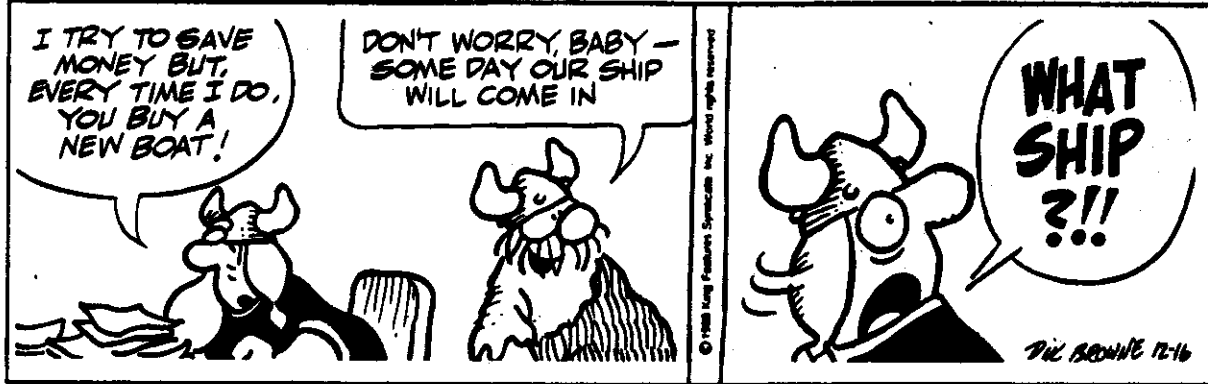
