

HOW TO REACH THEPLANNING MEETING

By Land, Head east on Forest Drive (Rt. 665) from Rt. 2 at Parole, through 9 traffic lights at which time you will be on Bay Ridge Road. Pass the Bay Ridge gates and turn left onto East Lake Drive. Bear right and go .4 mile to the sign on the left for the Bay Ridge Civic Association Clubhouse. Turn in and you will find plenty of parking.

For those of you who love to frostbite sail, you will find the Lake Ogleton entrance NM of Tolly Point. Be sure that #1 \$ #5 flashers stay lined up with your fore and aft stays. Don't let the tide carry you out of the channel. Boats with 5' draft go in and out at all times with no trouble. Once inside bear to port and you will find plenty or room to anchor in good water. The Clubhouse is at the East end of the lake at the marina. Just dinghy in!
